Do you have to be an archivist to join?

Annual dues received after September 1 are applied to the following year. Current members can also renew through the same webpage.

How much will my dues cost?

Students enrolled in a degree-granting program pay \$15; individuals pay \$30; and institutions pay \$40.



What are the benefits of being a member?

- Membership and student rates for conferences, workshops, and events
- Subscription to the quarterly *NEA Newsletter* and any other free NEA publications
- Access to an online membership directory, connecting you to hundreds of archivists across the region
- Eligibility to vote in leadership elections and on important organizational issues at the annual meeting in the spring
- Eligibility to hold leadership positions and to participate in roundtable interest groups
- Eligibility to compete for sponsored awards (student members are also eligible to compete for the Student Writing Prize)
